OLD BUSINESS

Payment of Bills

Resident Irene Hyer questioned what the outstanding invoice from Strand Pool for \$2800 was for? The BOD responded that this was a past due unpaid balance from the Floss administration.

Snow Removal

We all recently experienced "the perfect storm". Due to limited funds, the BOD decided to continue to use Jeff Shirley for snowplowing for the second year in a row. Right now, only NIck's truck is operable. Louis Mecka's plow broke down- he is no longer able to help plow the community roads.

Several residents then asked questions: Mr. Lediard, new to the community, asked about contractors not wanting to work with our community. He suggested that we should n investigate purchasing equipment at auctions.

President White asked resident John Corrie if he would like to volunteer to join in and help communication in Gate 3. Director Wexler volunteered to make phone calls, answer questions and update residents during storm events. It was agreed the the biggest issue n is lack of communication during the storms. Pat Morley, a resident in Gate 2, also volunteered to be a coordinator. A discussion then ensued regarding having a special page set up on our website as a central location-perhaps a "snow page" on our site. Resident Maz Cruz, our IT coordinator will work on this.

Resident Fwler spoke about the need for a central site for all alerts- not just for snow. Her idea was to use SMS messaging using people's cell phone #'s.

Resident Donald McConnell had a novel idea of creating a volunteer emergency shuttle within the community. The shuttle would pick up people and get them to their cars that would be parked in parking lot at front gates. The emergency parking area during storms would have to be cleared out with a backhoe.]

Ratification of actions needed:

VP Hiorth made a motion to ratify ordering of grit, sand, salt.

Treasurer Swift seconded the motion.

On 3/23/21 there will be an 11 AM status conference on this case.

Treasurer Swift and President White are ready to go through financial reports but h=they have received no directives yet form the Judge or the Court.
